Directions

From the Train Station to the Institute:

Arrival at the Hauptbahnhof Würzburg (Central Station). You can reach the main area of the University Hospital with the tram no. 5 (towards Grombühl). The tram heads directly to the Institute and is generally available every 10 minutes. The ride will take about 6 minutes. Please leave the tram at the stop "Uni-Klinikum Bereich D, Würzburg". Across the street, about 10 meters up the hill, you will see a big steel gate for pedestrians. After you have passed that gate, you will see a yellow building directly in front of you. This is building D15, in which the Rudolf Virchow Center (RVZ), the Institute of Molecular Infection Biology (IMIB) and the Helmholtz Institute for RNA-based Infection Research (HIRI) are located. The walk from the Main Station to the institute takes about 20-25 minutes.

At the Institute:

Walk to your left up the hillside around the building where you will find the Main Entrance. The purple area in the map denotes the construction site of the new HIRI building. When you enter the foyer, please walk up the stairs to the 1st floor and you will be right in front of the Large Seminar Room 01.002-004.
